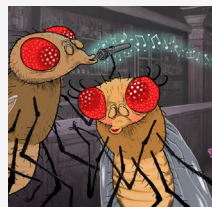

Research conducted at Texas A&M represented annual expenditures of more than \$892 million in fiscal year 2016. Texas A&M ranked in the top 20 of the National Science Foundation's Higher Education Research and Development survey (2015), based on expenditures of more than \$866 million in fiscal year 2015.
