

## Responsible Conduct of Research Equivalent Course Approval Request

As detailed in TAMU SAP 15.99.99.M0.04 Responsible Conduct of Research, four hours of face-to-face (F2F) training is required for graduate students participating in externally funded research and all postdoctoral researchers. We understand that many departments already offer a course that covers many of the RCR training topics. These courses must be submitted for review and approval by the RCR before the course may be counted toward the RCR training requirements. To be eligible for course equivalency the offered course must be at least four hours long and contain at least four of the RCR themes listed below.
